ABOUT DIA

The Documentation and Information Centre on Anti-Semitism Mecklenburg-Western Pomerania (*Dokumentations- & Informationsstelle Antisemitismus Mecklenburg-Vorpommern*, DIA.MV) is an independent reporting and advisory body, which records, evaluates and publishes anti-Semitic incidents free of charge. Our goal is to empower Jewish and non-Jewish people affected by anti-Semitism. Documenting anti-Semitic incidents helps to raise awareness of the fact that anti-Semitism is a problem affecting society as a whole and to draw greater attention to the issue in civil society.

We document anti-Semitic incidents regardless of their relevance under criminal law. Incidents do not have to be reported to the police as a prerequisite for being recorded by us! Affected persons, relatives, acquaintances and witnesses are all welcome to contact the DIA.MV. We act in the interests of the affected party, treating each case confidentially and anonymously if so wished.

Where necessary, we also offer assistance with legal action or psychosocial measures. In addition, we provide a point of contact for individuals and institutions who wish to inform themselves and play an active role in combating anti-Semitism.

As a documentation and information centre committed to advising affected persons, it is particularly important for us to learn about your views and needs!
